Technical Note - Pairing CS60 Headsets

General:

Occasionally a CS60 Wireless headset may lose connection to its base unit/cradle. When this happens, the headset will not work. This situation may be caused by the base unit losing power at a time that the headset is not sitting in it. This can be due to your power utility having a power supply failure or an electrician turning the power off for protection while they work.

The solution to this is to restore the pairing (i.e. connectivity).

Pairing Process:

Follow the following steps to pair the CS60 headset to its Base Unit:

- 1. Power down the Base Unit
- 2. Power up the Base Unit
- 3. Ensure that the headset is in its Base Unit cradle
- 4. At the rear of the Base Unit locate the + and the buttons. Press both these simultaneously along with the mute button located on the top of the headset.
- 5. Hold the three buttons down until the green LED on the headset flashes then stays on solid.
- 6. Release the three buttons.
- 7. Wait for the green LED to go out (approx 20 seconds).
- 8. Headset is ready for use.
